CREATING AN ENVIRONMENT THAT PROMOTES LEARNING AT HOME

PARENT CHECKLIST

An effective home school environment is best established when the following are in order:

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V DESK OR WORKSPACE

Have an area set-up in your home with a desk (a table with a laptop works as well) that your child can associate with school work.

COMPUTER (access to outlet)

Make sure your child's learning space includes a computer or laptop as well an electrical outlet.

SCHOOL BOOKS & SUPPLIES

Gather all school books and supplies (pens, paper, dictionary, globe, glue etc) and keep them within reach of your child's learning space.

JESIGNATED AREAS

Bins, crates and other types of storage containers will really come in handy for organizing your child's school supplies.

V TIMER / BELL

Keep a timer so that your child has a visual reference for how long an activity should take. A bell can also be used to notify a certain activty has ended.

V POSTED SCHEDULE

Routines give a sense of safety, especially in times of uncertainity. Post all charts, routines and schedules for your child to refer to for guidance.
